

ORDER OF THE ARROW ADULT NOMINATION

Each year, upon holding a troop or team election for youth candidates which results in at least one youth candidate being elected, the unit committee may recommend adult candidates to the lodge adult selection committee. The number of adults nominated can be no more than one-third of the number of youth candidates elected, rounded up where the number of youth candidates is not a multiple of three. In addition to the one-third limit, the unit committee may nominate the currently serving unit leader (but not assistant leaders), as long as he or she has served as unit leader for at least the previous 12 months. The following conditions are the basis for candidate selection and **MUST** be fulfilled to be considered.

- ⇒ Adults must meet the same camping requirements as youth candidates (minimum of 15 days and nights of Scout camping, of which 6 must be a long-term camp).
- ⇒ Selection of the adult is based upon the ability to perform the necessary functions to help the youth of the Order to fulfill its purpose, not for recognition.
- ⇒ The adult leader's membership will provide for a positive role model for the growth and development of the youth members of the Lodge.
- ⇒ The individual will be an asset to the Order due to demonstrated skills and abilities, which will fulfill the purpose of the Order.

Who may be nominated: Any adult (21 years of age) in Samoset Council who is registered as a Boy Scout Leader. Cub Scout and Venture Crew adults are not eligible.

Who may nominate adult leaders in units: The unit committee chairperson or Scoutmaster upon the recommendation of the Troop Committee may nominate any adult who is primarily registered in their Troop. One adult may be nominated for each 3 Scouts elected to the Order.

Who may nominate adult leaders in Council & District Positions: The District Chairperson, Council President, or member of the Professional Staff may propose adults who are primarily registered with their respective Council or District Committees.

Deadline: A youth election is a prerequisite. All nomination forms must be mailed or hand delivered directly to the Lodge Advisor by May 1, even if the youth election has not been held by that point. Notification will be sent out by May 31, as to your nominee's status.
